Kilkelly lies on the main roads between Swinford $6\frac{1}{2}$ M. north-west and Ballyhaunis 9 M. south-south-east; (and) Kiltinagh $6\frac{1}{2}$ M. west and Ballyhadereew 12 M. east-north-east.

A small country town of 70 houses grouped so as to form a 'T' shaped street formation - the main st. being a few hundred yds. long running north to south and having a shortish street running east from it. The junction of the streets forms a small 'square'. There are a few two-storey premises and there are pavements. Mostly two-storey houses, a good few of which need brightening up. The church is just outside the town, on a hill.
