Situate 2 1/2 miles south of Manilla; 6 M. south-east of Castletown and about 1/2 M. west of Rella (by road distance).

The village main street has on its west side: a small thatched cottage, a two-story ruin, two single-story slated cottages, a 50 yd. row of untidy two-story dwellings, some most ancient, a two-story ruin, a two-story shop, two further dwellings, two-story; a modern bungalow, a small shed, the P.O. a neat building and a few thatched cottages further on. On east side are a long slated barn, a small thatched wreck, a good + well-kept 2-story shop, and a few ruins. A little distance from the street, along other road, are a church ruin, a tall alley, and on opposite side the Catholic church with beside it the most well-kept house.
