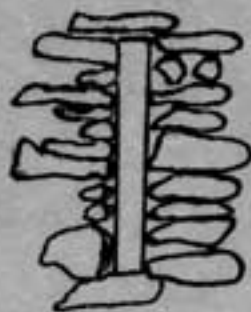
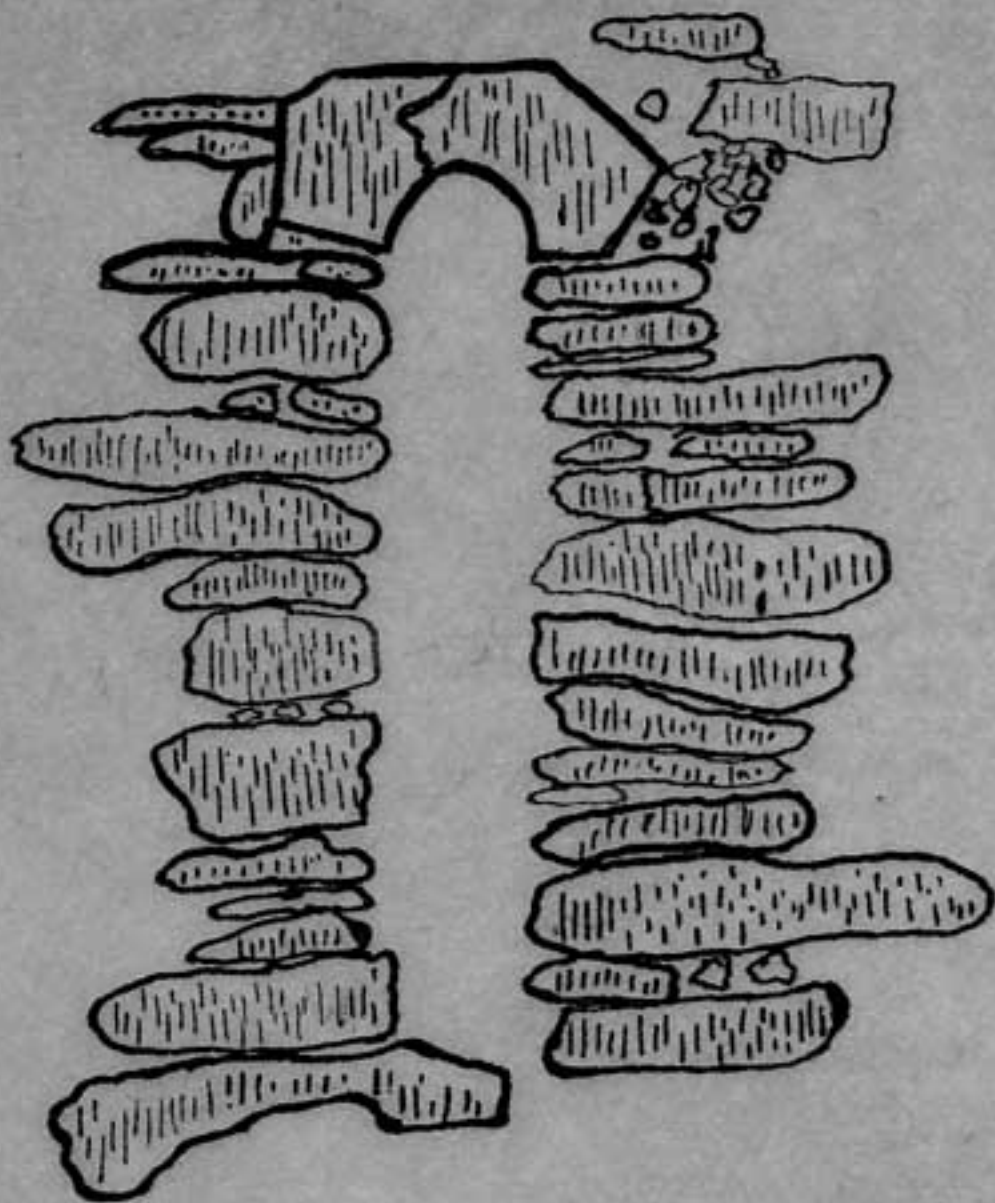

Window South Sidewall KILGEEVER Old Church.



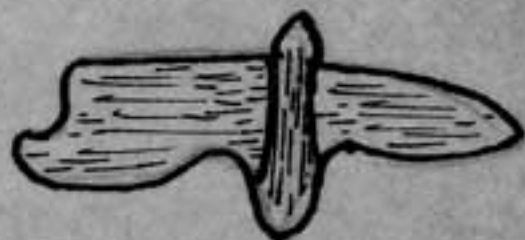
WINDOW EAST GABLE KILGEEVER

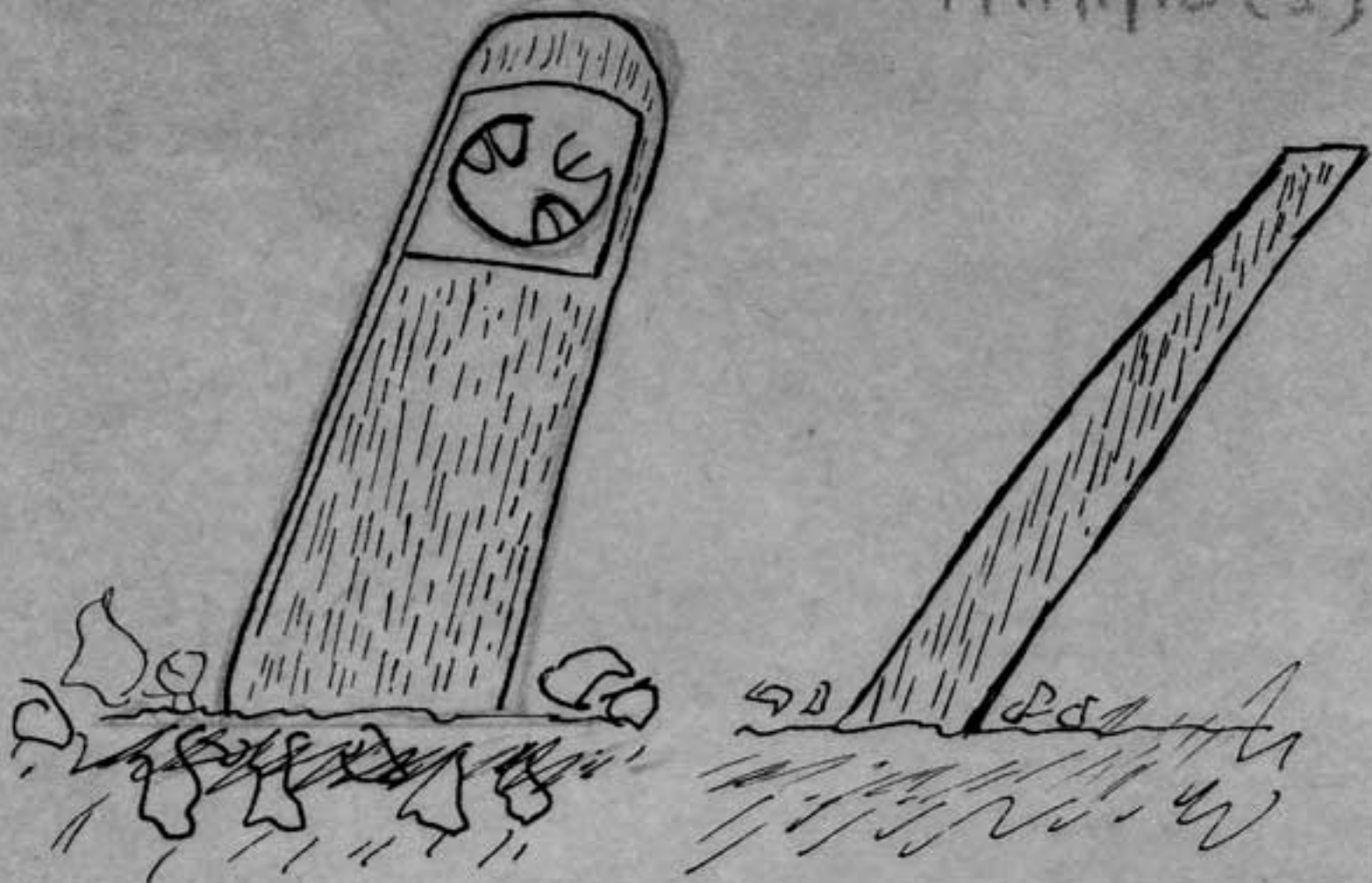


STANDING STONE WITH

AXE AT TOBERBRIDE.

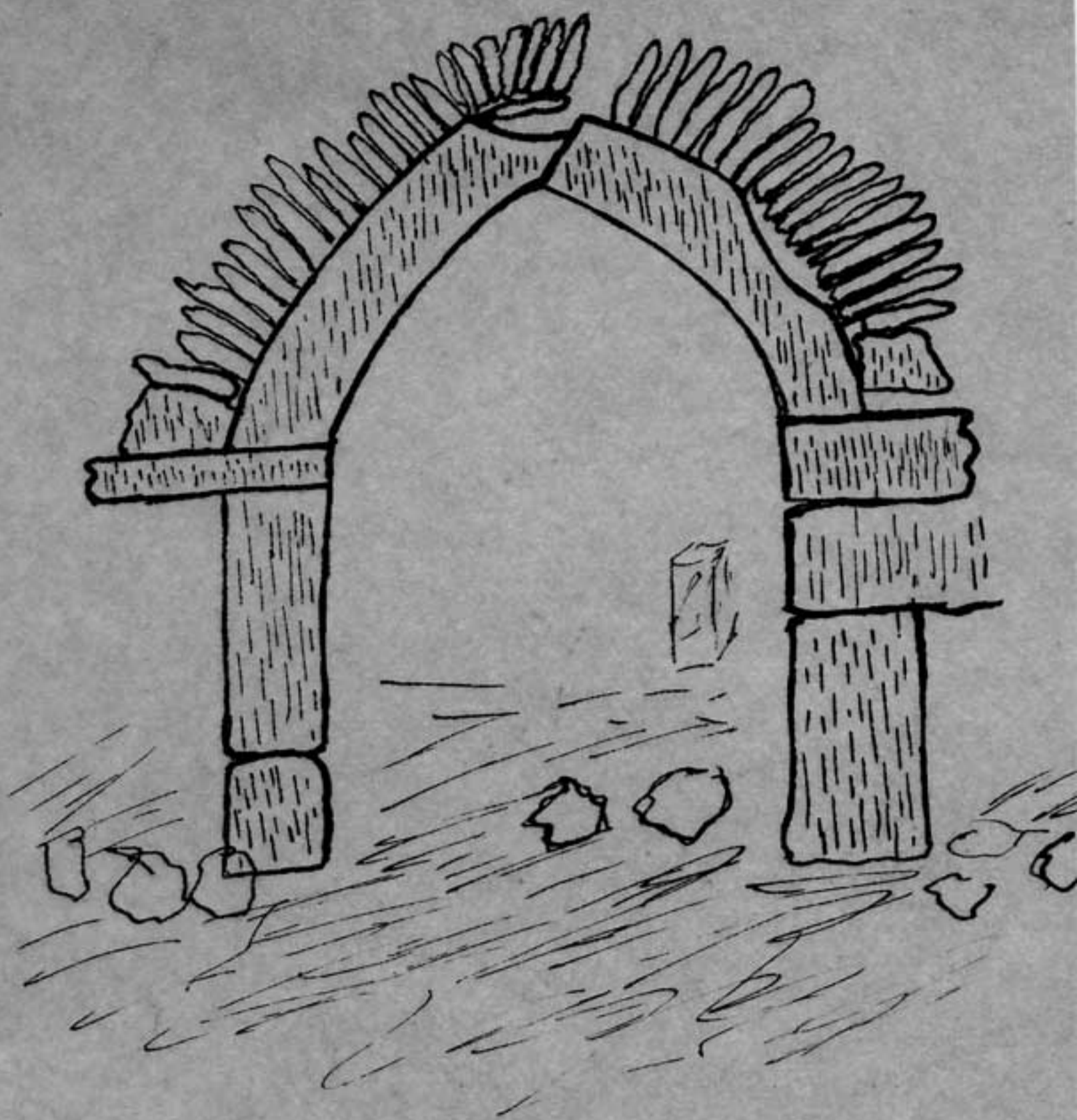

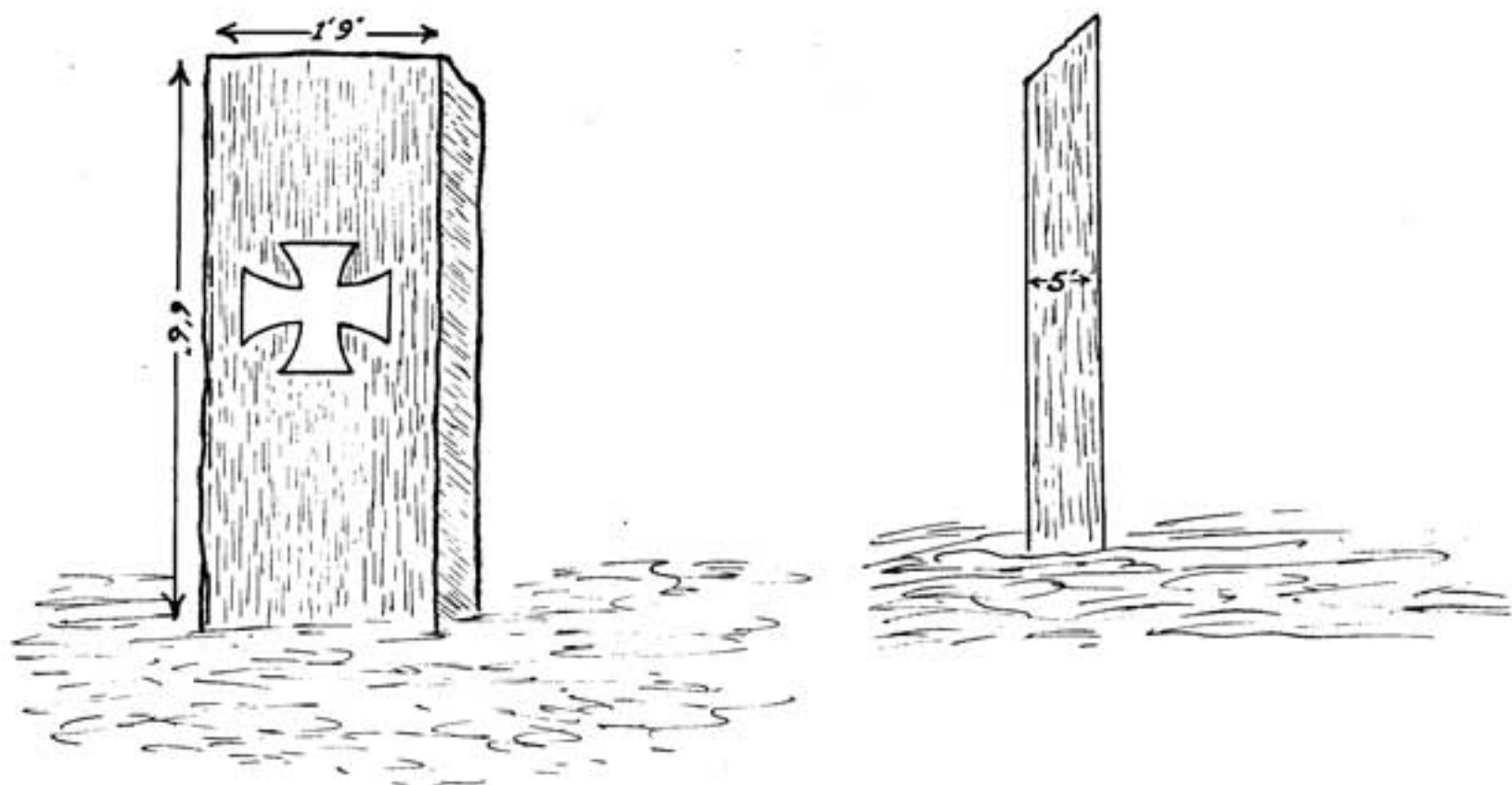

Standing Stone: Situated about 40 yards from the
 base west of the Mc Kenas house in the townland of
 Dacreen. 12 miles from Kesh'sburgh. The
 monuments are all free above. The cross measures
 1'6" high by 1'3" wide and is cut in bold
 relief. According to tradition a bishop is said
 to have been buried here, and some years ago
 bones were found beside this stone. The
 foundations of what is said to have been a
 monastery may also be traced close by.
