Killawalla Community Lotto is back and running after a break due to Covid 19. Jackpot €4,850. Next draw Sunday 4th October in the Community Centre after 10am Mass. Draw every fortnight after that. Same time and venue until further notice.

Due to Covid 19 restrictions the lotto had to be stopped. Last draw was 1st March. Due to HSE restrictions sellers are no longer able to go door to door, so the following was purposed. If possible annual tickets to be purchased for €50. This will mean you are in the draw for the year. If you wish to buy fortnightly that also fine. Tickets remain at the same 1 line €2 3 lines €5. these envelopes will be able to purchase in Pakie McEvilleys Pub, Corrigans Store or from any Community Council member.
