## Mayo County Council Planning and Development Acts 2000-2013

## **Declaration under Section 57 Application Form**

The above Act provides that any works which would affect the character of the protected structure, or a proposed protected structure will require planning permission, even where those works would normally be exempted under Section 4(1)(h) of the 2000 Act.

As an owner or occupier of a protected structure you are entitled under the above Act to request the County Council to issue a declaration as to the type of works which may or may not be permitted in the structure. In order to issue this declaration, you should supply the following information:

## NOTES

Application shall be accompanied by 1 copy of site location map to the scale of 1:1000 clearly identifying the structure and boundaries to which the application refers (subject structure to be <u>outlined in red</u>, overall land holding to be <u>outlined in blue</u>).

It should be noted that the section 57 requires a detailed survey of the internal and external features of the structure.
