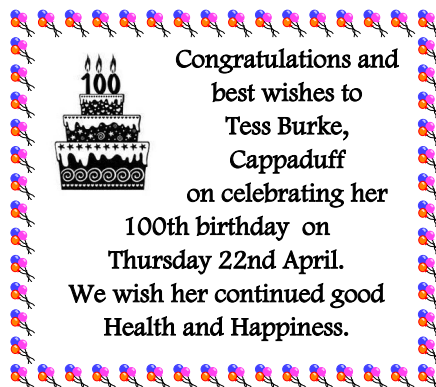

Due to Covid 19 Restrictions, we have to curtail our celebrations of this historic event in Tourmakeady. However, the following events will be taking place –

2ND MAY, 2021 - Mass will be celebrated in St Mary's Church, Tourmakeady, Sunday at 11.30am for the IRA Volunteers and the Cumann na mBan members and also for the men that died on 3rd of May, 1921. The mass can be viewed on – churchtvtourmakeady.ie

3rd MAY, 2021 - There will be private prayer services at the graves of Michael O'Brien, Cong, Patrick Feeney, Ballin-

robe, and Tom Horan, Tourmakeady.

3rd MAY, 2021 - There will be a 'sod turning' ceremony in Tourmakeady and in Srah, the 'Last Post' will be played and Shona Ní Mháille will perform one of the Ambush Poems that she has composed and arranged the music for. Shona hopes to release a CD of these songs/poems during this centenary year.

3rd MAY, 2021 - A new book – 'The Tourmakeady Ambush' will be launched.
